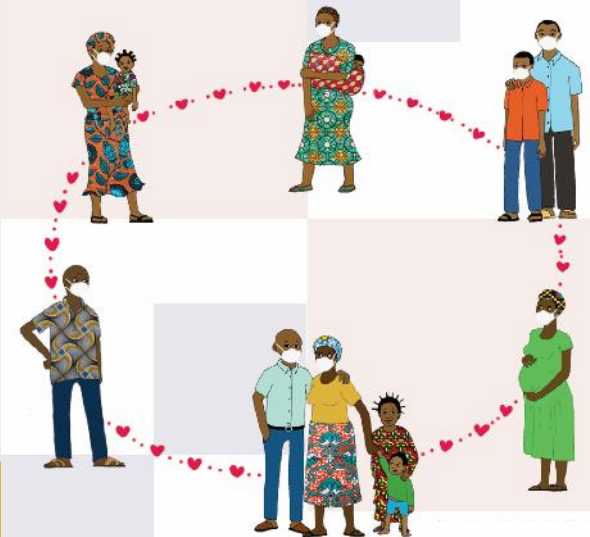
While we wait to access the COVID-19 vaccines, we need to continue, now more than ever, to ensure we follow simple steps for PREVENTION that work...

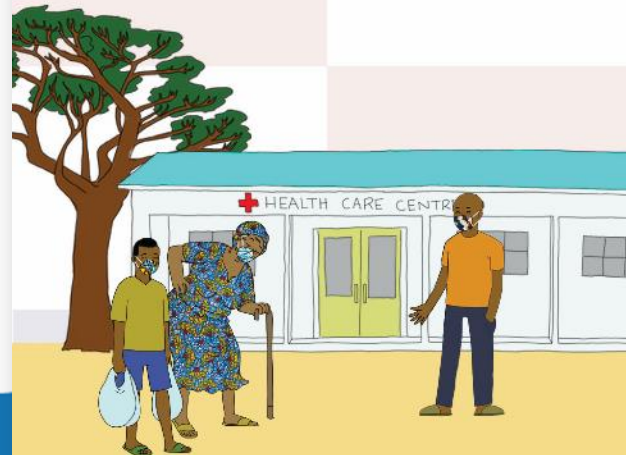

Approved COVID-19 vaccines bring new hope in our lives: they mark the beginning of the end of this difficult time.



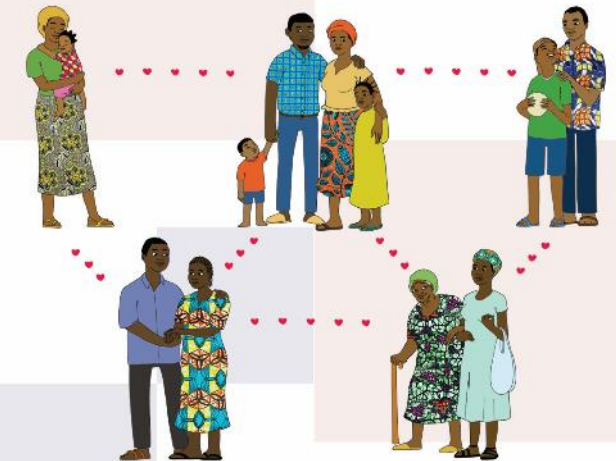

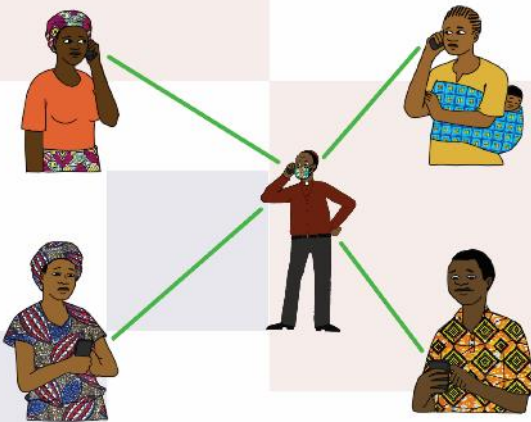

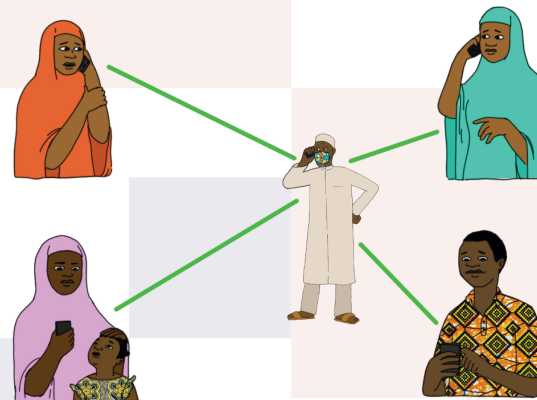
